<u>Item 5 – Discussion, Accept and Acknowledge the Receipt of Funds from Proposition 8 – Next Generation 9-1-1 Service Fund – House Bill 9 (HB 9) – Texas Broadband Infrastructure Fund – in the amount of \$1,082,797.50 for NG9-1-1 implementation. (BR25-01 – Resolution)</u>

The Board discussed and approved the receipt of \$1,082,797.50 from the Texas Broadband Infrastructure Fund (House Bill 9) for the implementation of Next Generation 9-1-1 (NG9-1-1) services. Swanson explained that the funds, secured through an application to the State of Texas, will be used specifically for NG9-1-1, with no funds from the 9-1-1 budget being used. This amount complements a previously received grant of over \$3 million for the same purpose. Boardmembers expressed support, with no objections raised, and the resolution was unanimously approved to accept the funds.

Boardmember Rice motioned to acknowledge the item as presented; Boardmember Pope seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Item 6 – Discussion, Accept and Acknowledge the District Administration's recommendation of awarding the NG9-1-1, ESInet and Call Handling Equipment project to AT&T Enterprises, LLC. (BR25-02 – Resolution)

The Board discussed and approved the recommendation to award the contract for the Next Generation 9-1-1 (NG9-1-1) system, including the Emergency Services IP Network (ESInet) and Call Handling Equipment, to AT&T Enterprises, LLC. The total project cost is \$3,945,674.80, with the first year's costs of \$2.5 million covered by the grant and House Bill 9 funds. The recurring annual cost for the next four years is approximately \$342,000, which will be offset by savings from deactivating older technologies.

Details on four optional enhancements, including text-to-9-1-1, GIS data validation, and a wireless redundancy option that will improve system functionality. The project is expected to begin in the first quarter of the year and be completed by end of year 2025.

The motion to approve the resolution passed unanimously.
